Preface



A true Muslim knows with full conviction that in this universe, after the Prophets and Messengers, the most noble and exalted personality is that of Abu Bakr . He was blessed with the friendship and companionship of the Prophet \$\mathbb{z}\$ long before he attained Prophethood. Abu Bakr \$\pi\$ earned the honour of being among the first Muslims who pledged allegiance to the Prophet \$\mathbb{z}\$ and from then until the end of his life, Abu Bakr \$\pi\$ spent every moment serving and obeying the Prophet \$\mathbb{z}\$, and submitting completely to Islamic rulings.

The extent of his love and devotion to the Messenger of Allah & was such that he readily sacrificed his entire life and wealth. The Messenger of Allah 衰 also loved him immensely and bestowed on him the honour of being his closest Companion during the migration to Al-Madinah. During his final illness and in the days before his death, the Prophet \$ appointed Abu Bakr & to lead the Muslims in prayer and made it clear that Allah and the Believers would not accept any other person as the Imam of Muslims. Throughout his life, the Prophet 5 kept Abu Bakr & at his side, and very often the Prophet \$\% would mention the names of both Abu Bakr & and 'Umar Ibn Al-Khattab & when speaking of himself. This close companionship was so pleasing to the Lord of the Worlds, Allah made certain that Abu Bakr As-Siddeeq & would be buried next to the Prophet . On the Day of Resurrection, when the Prophet * rises from his grave, Abu Bakr & will follow him. On the Day of Judgment, when the Prophet % is stationed at Hawd-e-Kawther, Abu Bakr & will be with him. And while the Prophet 紫 will be the first of all the Noble Prophets to knock on the Gate of Paradise, his Companion in the cave, Abu Bakr & will be the first among the Ummah to knock on the Gate.

After the death of the Messenger of Allah %, the gaze of all of his noble Companions was fixed on Abu Bakr &. The Muslim community did not delay in electing Abu Bakr & as the Khalifah of the Messenger of Allah %.

Faced with various trials and tribulations, including Musailamah "The Liar", those who refused to pay Zakah, and the apostates who rejected Islam, Abu Bakr & proved himself to be a true and decisive leader. Abu Bakr & rose up and said: "Say to the army of Usamah & to proceed to where our beloved Prophet Muhammad % ordered them to proceed." But when the bravest of the noble Companions namely Ali Ibn Abi Talib & and 'Umar Ibn Al-Khattab & objected to this saying to Abu Bakr &



"You are sending out this army at a time when the city of Al-Madinah is endangered from every side, who then will defend it against an attack?" Abu Bakr & responded saying, "The army of Usamah Ibn Zaid will be dispatched under all circumstances, because I cannot untie the flag that the Messenger of Allah & had himself tied." When someone said, "The commander, Usamah &, is very young," Abu Bakr & answered him with firm faith and resolve: "Abu Bakr will never accept the dismissal of the one who was appointed as the leader of the army by the Prophet &."The army of Usamah Ibn Zaid & then proceeded toward Balqa' and returned after defeating the enemy and waving the banners of victory.

When some of the tribes refused to pay Zakah, Abu Bakr announced: "Unsheathe your swords. The Shari'ah of Muhammad will never be changed in my presence. Force will be used against the person who, during the lifetime of the Prophet s, used to give a camel's headband and now refuses to even do this."

Abu Bakr & chose Khalid Ibn Al-Waleed & to deal with the false prophet, Musailamah "The Liar". In addition, when surrounding tribes apostatized and attempted to conquer Al-Madinah, Abu Bakr &, addressed his Companions: "The apostates will not be allowed to reach Al-Madinah. We will leave Al-Madinah and attack their settlements, and I will lead this army." History shows that Abu Bakr & took decisions that were one-hundred percent correct. Within two years he was able to establish peace and security throughout the land.


